# Scenarios & Strategy

- Management together with Executive Board
  - Preparing scenarios
    - For the development of the RIPE NCC
    - For preparedness of possible and likely changes in environment



# Current Focus and Activities - 1

- Internal focus
  - Content Management System (CMS) in development
  - K-root server network upgrade to CentOS completed
  - Technical security audit done and implemented
  - Network infrastructure audit ongoing



# Current Focus and Activities - 2

- External focus
  - Deployment of IPv6 in root zone completed
  - Information Services:
    - RIS Prefix Dashboard and AS Dashboard now available
    - Enhancements made to TTM and DNSMON services
      - DNSMON now supports monitoring of IPv6
  - RIPE Database:
    - Non-personal Near Real-Time Mirroring (NRTM) stream available in 2008
    - Close coordination with Data Protection Task Force
  - Reclaiming unused address space:
    - Over 1,806,336 IP addresses returned so far
      - /12, /13, /15, /16, /17, /20



# Current Focus and Activities - 3

- External focus
  - Enhanced Cooperation
    - Task force and working group preparations
  - Training Services:
    - LIR training course totally rewritten
      - Launched in January
      - More interaction
      - More practical exercises
      - New audiences: universities, governments, law enforcement
    - E-Learning platform overhaul
      - Includes IPv6 module (in development)

# RIPE Policy

- RIPE Policy Development Process document is updated
  - Appeals process added
  - Language improved
- Three proposals accepted (since July 2007):
  - IPv6 Address Allocation and Assignment Policy
  - IANA Policy for Allocation of ASN Blocks to RIRs
  - Proposal to Amend the IPv6 Assignment and Utilisation Requirement Policy
- Two proposals were withdrawn:
  - Change in IP Assignments for Anycasting DNS Policy
  - IPv4 Countdown Policy





# Certification in the RIPE Region

- Project driven by RIPE NCC Activity Plan
- Need explicit community input
  - Adoption likely?
  - Interaction with business processes?
- Rising interest from other stakeholders
- RIPE Certification Task Force
  - RIPE NCC increased efforts on prototype installation and integration
  - Task Force held third meeting during RIPE 55 Meeting
  - Next report at RIPE 56 Meeting
  - Deployment of prototype in 2008



# Membership & Regional Outreach

- About 5,400 members
  - Strongest growth in Russia, UK and Italy
- RIPE NCC Regional Meetings 2008
  - Salmiya, Kuwait, 15-17 April
  - Moscow, Russia, 23-24 September
- Middle East Operators Group (MENOG)
  - Organisational/administrative support for MENOG
  - MENOG 3 to be held alongside NCC Regional Meeting in Kuwait
  - MENOG 4 to be held alongside RIPE 57 Meeting in Dubai
- Membership Survey
  - In preparation now and to be conducted this year



# Governments & “Enhanced Cooperation”

- RIPE Enhanced Cooperation Task Force
  - Held first session during RIPE 55 Meeting in Amsterdam
  - Draft charter
  - Likely evolving into a RIPE Working Group
- External Relations
  - Activities targeted towards and with governments
  - PR consultancy engaged
  - Cooperation with the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD)
- Internet Governance Forum (IGF)
  - Preparations for the next IGF to be held in December 2008



# RIPE 55 - Amsterdam

- Best attended meeting ever (375 attendees, 40 countries)
- Community statement: “RIPE Community Resolution on IPv4 Depletion and Deployment of IPv6”
