## APNIC training - background

- Training is an important and fundamental member service
- Training helps
  - develop better capabilities
  - improve knowledge and understanding
  - adopt BCPs in internet operational technologies
- eLearning will help more members access this service

# Why APNIC eLearning?

- Remote Access Survey, Dec. 2005
  - 86% of respondents supported development of eLearning
  - Only 31% had attended an on-line course
- Making training more widely accessible – across time zones and geographic boundaries
- Complementing face-to-face training
  - On-line pre-requisite module frees up face-to-face training sessions
  - Trainers can dedicate more time to more advanced and practical skills training
  - The creation of simulations where technologies are not available for training

# Why use eLearning?

## eLearning ...

- is free of charge
- is more accessible
- allows you to manage your own learning
- gives you virtual access to trainers
- gives you better opportunities to gain knowledge

    - use the new form
    - prepare your IPv4 address application
    - seek help with your application
- Feedback
