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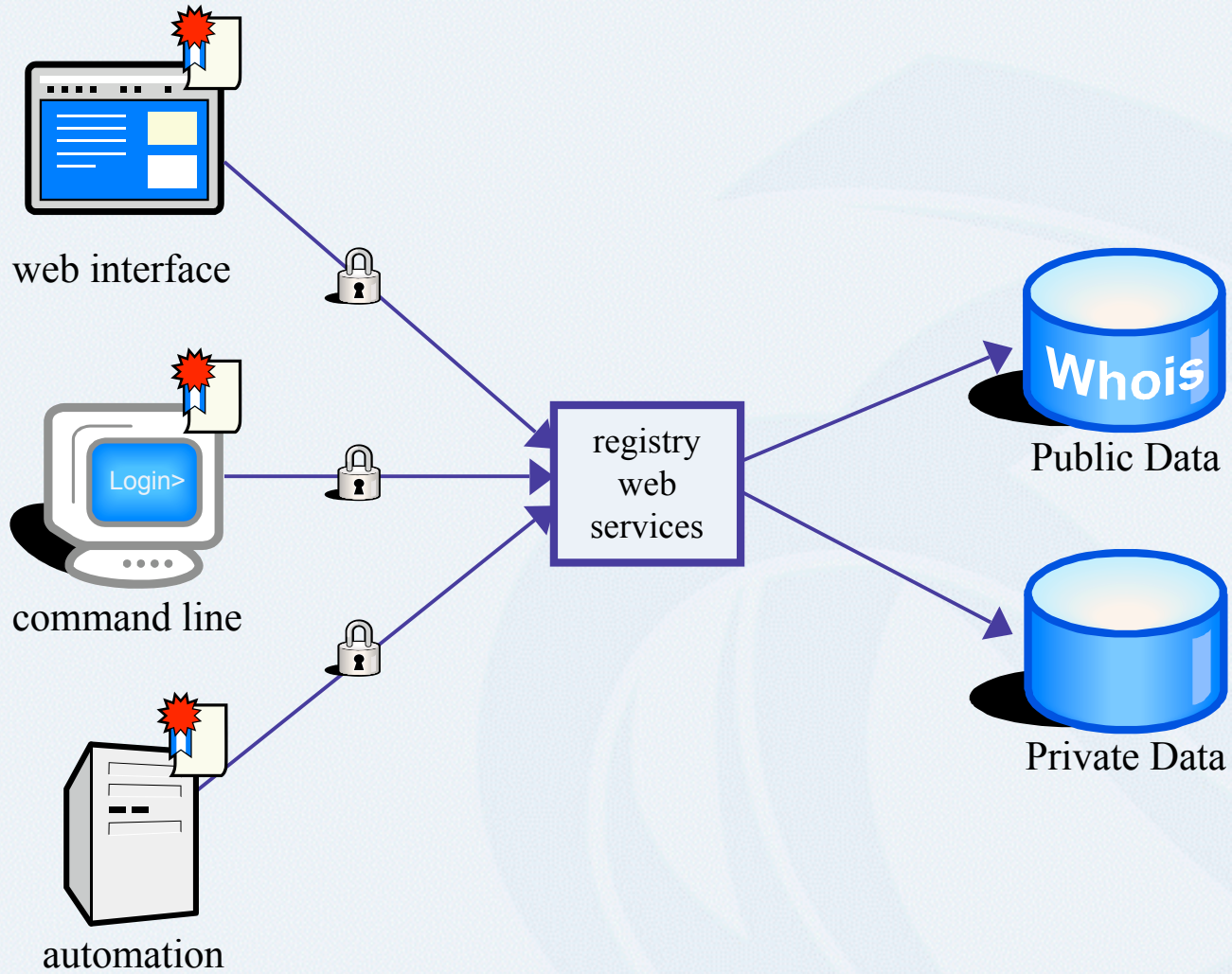
Proposal

- Secretariat to phase out email updates of registry and whois data
- Use more suitable methods

Motivation

- Improve security
 - CIA = Confidentiality, Integrity, Availability
- Lessens impact on UCE
 - Spam, viruses
 - Members reject autodbm@apnic.net emails
- Improved customer focused APNIC services
 - More fully functioned registry services
 - Privacy of data concerns

Benefits

- Encrypted transaction
 - Confidentiality
- Certificate authorisation
 - Integrity
- XML
 - Data integrity and consistency
- Service consistency
 - Immediate feedback / availability
- Automatable interface
 - Customer focused / easier to use



Implementation

- 2 months after EC endorsement
 - Tools and test environment
- 4 months
 - Domain objects
- 8 months
 - inetnum
 - inet6num
 - aut-num
- 12 months
 - All remaining objects
 - route-set, as-block, etc...

Summary

- Seek consensus from the community to phase out email updates of registry and whois data in favour of more suitable methods
