APNIC policy implementation update

- 4-byte AS number policy proposal
 - Endorsed after APNIC 21
 - 01 January 2007 Secretariat to assign 4-byte ASN
 - RIRs currently coordinating for readiness
- IANA policy for allocation of IPv6 blocks to RIRs
 - Adopted in all RIR regions
 - Submitted to ICANN for ratification
- Amend IPv6 HD ratio from 0.8 to 0.94
 - For subsequent allocation
 - Awaiting adoption from all RIRs

Discussion in IPv4

- Not many issues raised lately
 - Research focus on exhaustion
 - Debogon activity and resource recovery
- No consensus reached ‘Applying HD ratio to IPv4’ proposal in RIPE, LACNIC and APNIC
- AfriNIC adopted
 - End user IPv4 Portable assignments policy
 - Policy for temporary address assignments
- Proposal in RIPE to document /24 as minimum portable assignment size for multihoming

Policy proposal discussion in IPv6

- IPv6 for critical infrastructure policy
 - /48 min default under discussion in AfriNIC
 - /32 max assignment per operator proposed in APNIC [prop-041]
- IPv6 portable assignments for end user organisations
 - Discussion in all RIRs
 - ARIN adopted to assign min /48
 - Two APNIC policy proposals to be discussed [prop-034, prop-035]

Policy proposal discussion in IPv6

- IPv6 address allocation and assignment policy
 - Under discussion in RIPE and APNIC [prop-036]
 - Amend criteria, remove plan 200 x /48 end sites
 - Implemented in AfriNIC and LACNIC



Policy proposal discussion in IPv6

- Amend IPv6 assignment and utilisation requirement
 - Discussed in all regions [prop-033]
 - 0.94 HD ratio
 - Implemented by ARIN
 - APNIC awaits other RIRs
- Micro-allocation for internal infrastructure proposal
 - Under discussion in ARIN
