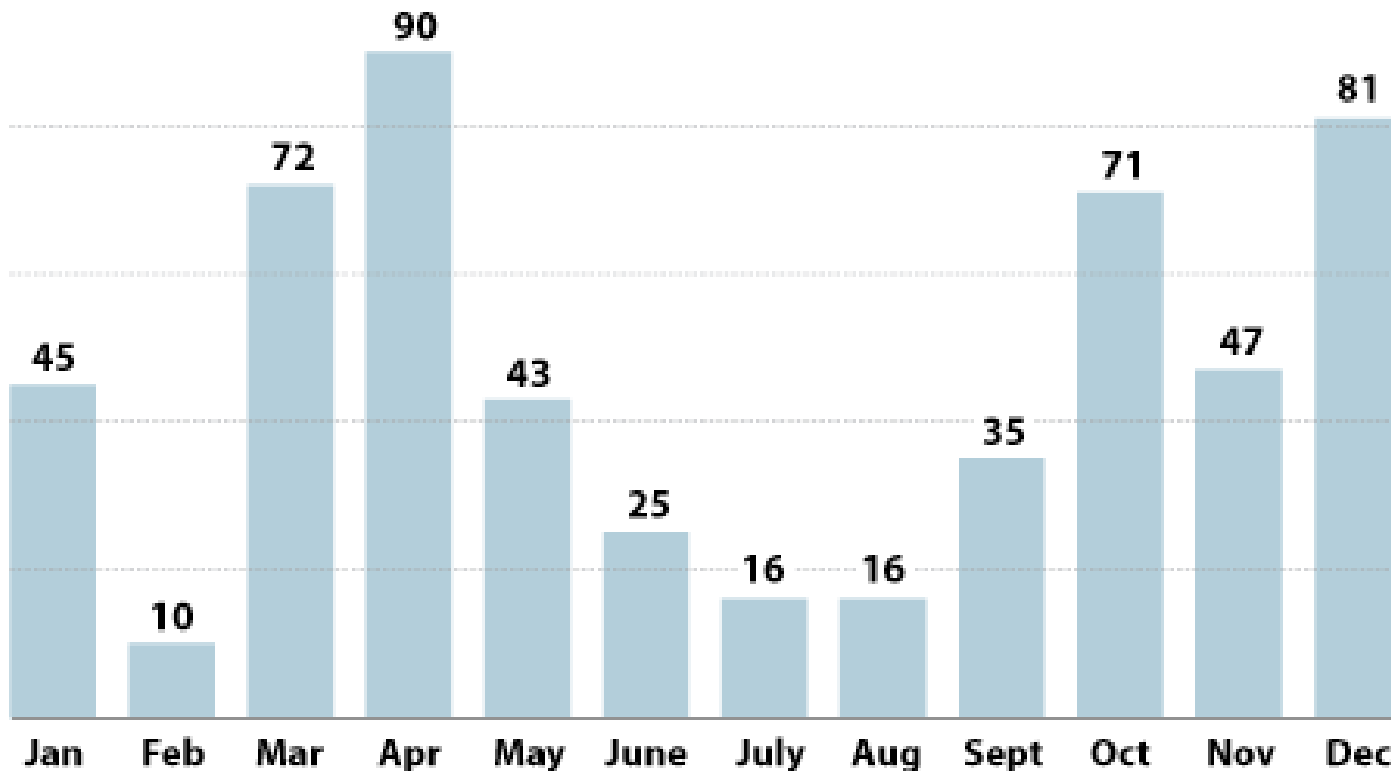
# Registration Services Agreement (RSA)

Updated: 17 February 2009

Section 3 makes more explicit ARIN's ability to terminate the agreement if an Applicant misrepresents information it provides to ARIN. This provision protects the community from fraudulent applications.

3. Expands petition process

# Policy Issues

## Adopted

1. Transfers
2. /10 IPv4 for IPv6 deployment
3. /22 minimum in the Caribbean region

## Under Discussion

1. Directory Services – data accuracy
2. IPv6 for Community Networks
3. IPv4 Recovery Fund
4. /20 limit per 6 months (ARIN < /9)
5. Global IANA to RIR IPv4 Policy
6. Transfer Appeals
